Artists' Place Gallery

During April, we will be exhibiting the unique works of **Sarah Gelsingr Brewer**.

In Sarah's artist statement she writes: My current body of artistic and mathematical work is an investigation into classical Islamic geometric designs, paying particular attention to the mathematical phenomenon of circle packing that arises organically from the underlying compass and straightedge construction of these patterns.

Generally, I am interested in the mathematical tools for making art, as well as the inherent beauty in pure mathematics. I currently teach these mathematical concepts and artistic skills, which include compass & straightedge constructions, mathematical perspective, tiling & tessellations, knot theory, wallpaper group classification, and origami, in a class called "Visual Mathematics" at the Alabama School of Math and Science.

My art has been influenced by mathematics since I began attending lectures on Knot Theory while working on my BFA at the University of South Alabama. A desire to further study the mathematical

field of topology led me to pursue my Master's degree in mathematics. Despite shifting fields, my art was always at the forefront, and my 2008 thesis ended up with over 100 pages of illustrations.

I started teaching my Visual Mathematics course about the same time as my last solo art show in 2010. While my work then was mathematically-inspired, it could not be classified as purely mathematical. My work these days is an expression of pure mathematics, allowing the process of geometric construction to play a prominent role visually.

Also featured in this show are some of my sketchbooks and journals that feature some of my early investigations into pattern and compass constructions. As hand-bookbinding and paper art in general have been great constants in my work throughout my life, I have chosen to display a number of my books and origami pieces alongside my geometric works.
