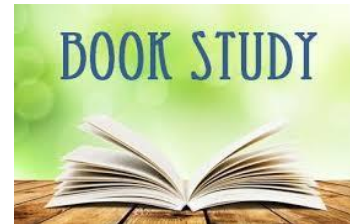

The Pilgrimage honoring Jonathan Myrick

Daniels, an Episcopal seminarian, begins in front of the courthouse in Hayneville. Pilgrims march to the jail

where Daniels and his companions were held, and from there to the place where he was killed, then back to the courthouse. In a moving Eucharist, the judge's bench of that 1965 trial becomes the altar on which the sacrament is consecrated. Fourteen other martyrs of the Alabama civil rights movement are recognized and honored in this service as well as Daniels. The keynote speaker this year is the Rev. Ed Bacon. A progressive spokesman on issues of faith and justice, he has been a regular guest host on Oprah Winfrey's Soul Series and has been named "Soul Teacher" on her list of 100 awakened leaders who are using their voice to elevate humanity.

Rethinking Preconceived Notions

During the month of August, the Artists' Place Gallery at the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer will be exhibiting the works of Abraham (Abe) Partridge.

In his own words:

This is the ART of ABE PARTRIDGE, from the cultural ghetto of Mobile, Alabama. I left Mobile when I was 18 in pursuit of a Theological education. I attended 4 bible colleges in 4 years... partly because I couldn't follow rules, partly because I knew better. I became a pastor of a small Independent Baptist Church in the Appalachians of Eastern Kentucky at 25 years old. When I was 27

years old I became acquainted with a horrible depression. I left the ministry and turned to ART. I have written songs and made paintings like these for years. Only after joining the military and going to war, did I decide to begin sharing my ART with the world. I never took a songwriting class, nor have I ever had an art class. I always just thought I was weird. Rethink preconceived notions. Question Authority. Create new methods of Survival. See beauty. - ABE
