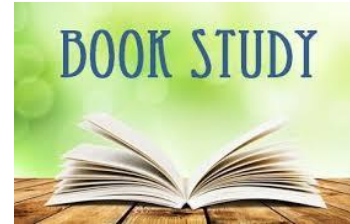

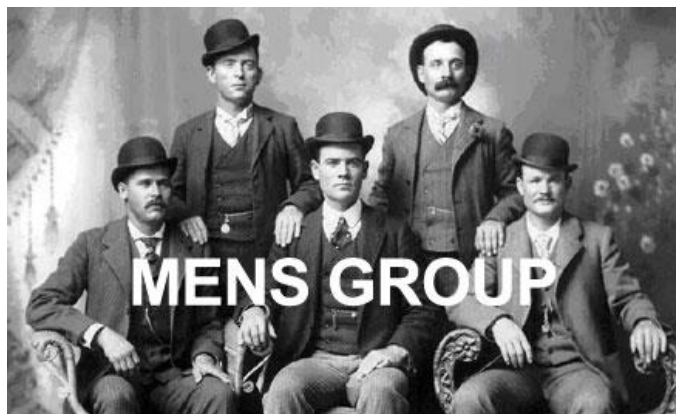
All shelves are labeled so that you can put your items on the shelves.

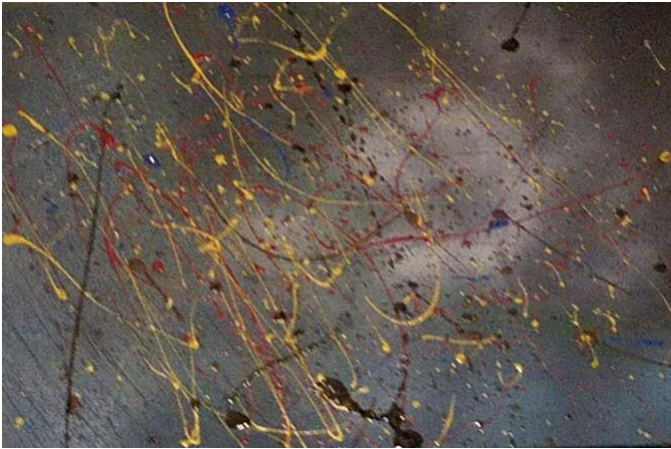
