I hope you will be present for this special day and bring a dish to share for our potluck brunch to follow our worship.

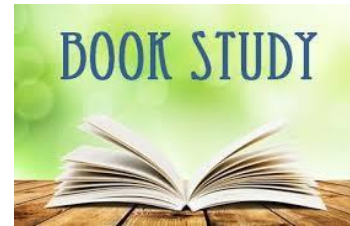
As always, I remain grateful for your faithfulness and devotion to the good news of God's Kingdom.

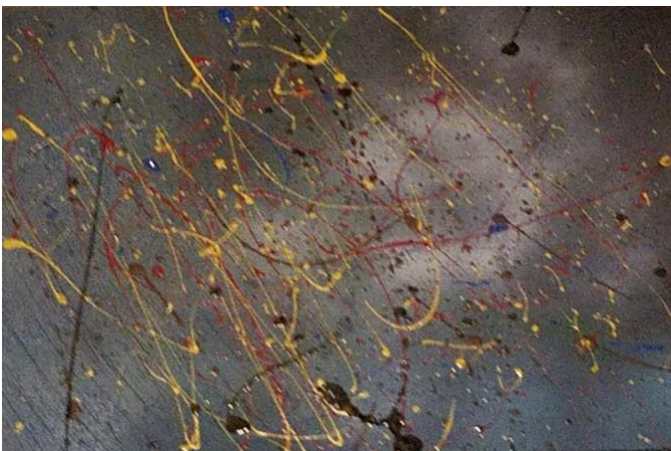

During the month of June, the Artists' Place Gallery at the Episcopal Church of the Redeemer will be exhibiting the works of eleven year old artist, Cecilia Archer.

Most recently she has been experimenting with spray and oil based paints. This is the majority of what is on display during this exhibit.

She is also heavily involved in charity work in her community. She helped create the Community Café at Redeemer, works with Family Promise and volunteers with Project Homeless Connect.

Having had to undergo major heart surgery at 6 months old, Cecilia knows that not every family is as fortunate as hers. She would like to be able to provide some comfort to others during their trying times.
